Second Chance for Pets is hosting the annual vaccination clinics on April 13th and April 20th. Everyone is invited to take advantage of this service regardless of the county of residence. Because of the remarkable supporters, services will be **FREE** this year. There will be a fee for Dewitt County rabies tags. Services include rabies, Bordetella, and Distemper vaccinations as well as microchips and nail trimming for both dogs and cats.

April 20th – Clinton (Clintonia Township Building (on north side of Clinton off Hwy 51 and N. Walnut St.)	1 p.m. – 3 p.m.

- \$FREE 1- year Rabies vaccination
- \$Free 3-year Rabies vaccination **must provide proof of previous vaccines**
- \$FREE Distemper/Parvo/Corona vaccine
- \$FREE Bordetella (kennel cough: recommended for pets that are boarded or groomed)
- \$FREE Microchip
- \$FREE Nail Trim

DEWITT COUNTY RABIES TAG REGISTRATION FEES

- \$15 1-year registration for pet (under 1 year old)
- \$15 1-year registration for altered/spayed/neutered pet
- \$25 1-year registration for unaltered pet
- \$38 3-year registration for altered/spayed/neutered pet
- \$65 3-year registration for unaltered pet

NOTICE: DEWITT COUNTY RESIDENTS MUST REGISTER THEIR PETS FOR A RABIES TAG AT TIME OF VACCINATION (EXCLUDES FERAL CATS)
